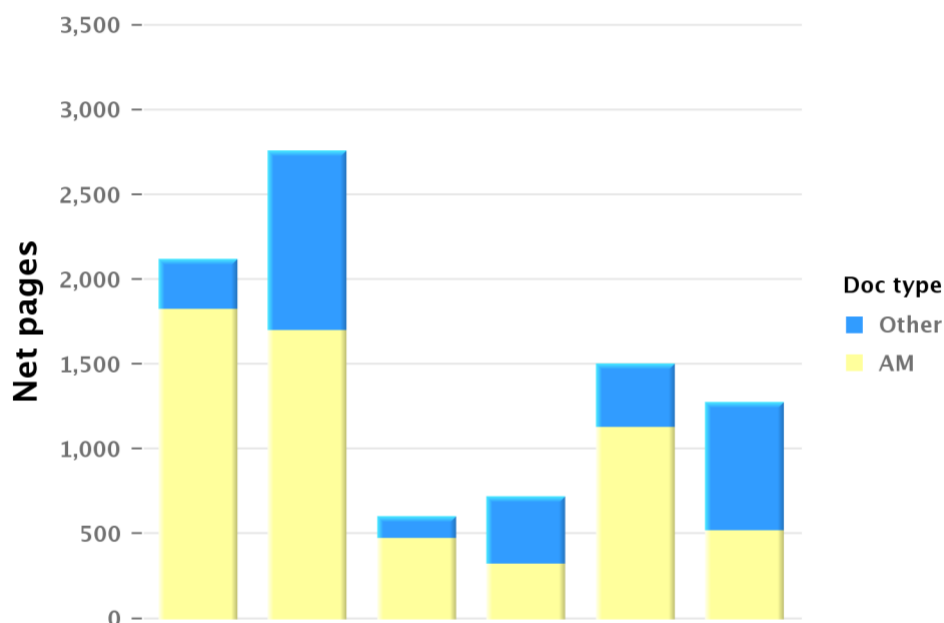
High workload – over 1 000 pages per week.

APRIL – MAY TRANSLATION FORECASTS

For the next six weeks, the forecast chart indicates a **very high level of submissions**, averaging around **1490 pages per week**.

Demand from committees is expected to remain consistently very high over this period, with a temporary dip during the April plenary week. However, the workload during that week is likely to be supplemented by plenary requests, which are not reflected in the charts.
